

GNM Examination Key Resources & Guidelines:

1. Important Websites for Official PDFs

Specific PDF links change often, but the following websites always provide the latest and authentic GNM-related documents:

a. Indian Nursing Council (INC)

- Primary source for **national GNM syllabus**, rules, and training regulations.
- Check sections like:
 - “**Syllabus and Regulations**”
 - “**Gazette Notifications**”

b. State Nursing Councils / State Boards

Each state publishes its own exam rules, notifications, and schedules. Examples:

- **West Bengal Nursing Council**
- **UP State Medical Faculty**
- **Karnataka State Nursing Council**
- **Maharashtra Nursing Council**

State rules may slightly differ in implementation from national INC guidelines.

2. General GNM Examination Guidelines

a. Eligibility Criteria

- Must have completed **10+2 with English**.
- Minimum **40% marks** in the qualifying exam.
- Science stream preferred.
- **ANM vocational course** students are also eligible.

b. Attendance & Internal Assessment

- Minimum **80% attendance** in both theory and practicals.
- Must score **at least 50% marks in internal assessments** separately in:
 - Theory
 - Practical

c. Examination Pattern

Entrance tests generally include **MCQs** from:

- General Science
- General Knowledge
- Basic English
- Logical Reasoning

d. Passing Criteria

- Minimum **50% overall** is required to pass.

e. Attempts & Course Duration

- Students usually get a **maximum of 6 years** to complete the GNM course (as per INC norms).

f. Admit Card / Roll Number

- Must carry:
 - Printed **Admit Card**
 - Valid **Photo ID** (Aadhaar, Voter ID, etc.)

g. OMR Sheet Instructions

- Carefully fill:
 - Roll Number
 - Question Booklet Series
 - Other required fields
 - Follow the instructions strictly to avoid disqualification.
